

## Mount Pleasant Lions Club Used Glasses and Hearing Aid Pickup Instructions

Once every month, first Monday or Tuesday pick up glasses from the following locations:

1. Mt. Pleasant Library (across from main desk)
2. Pleasant Optics (ask for glasses at receptionist desk)
3. Salvation Army (just inside the door)
4. Eye Sight on Broomfield Rd (in the entry way)  
1234 E Broomfield - In the Tallgrass Office Park
5. Central Eye (in the entry way)  
Broomfield Road and Sweeney St.
6. WalMart Vision Center. Large Box by entrance to vision center
7. Traverse Vision (box on south wall across from receptionist)  
Indian Hills Mall (next to Dollar Tree)
8. Chippewa Indian Reservation (Leaton Road Senior Center. May have to sign in and ask for glasses). They will call first.
9. Clark Funeral Home (every six months)
10. Lux Funeral Home (every six months)

### INSPECTING GLASSES

Check every pair of glasses for:

1. Missing for cracked lenses
2. Broken Frame
3. Nose piece broken or out of shape
4. Bows attached, not crooked or bent
5. Throw away broken glasses

### PACKING GLASSES

1. Pack eye glasses with case in a separate box
2. Pack eye glasses without case in a separate box. (Don't just throw in a box)
3. Sunglasses or dark lenses and loose lenses in a separate box.
4. Recommended box size 14 x 20, 9 x 14 X 14
5. Write on box its contents: i.e. Mt. Pleasant Lions glasses w/o case
6. About twice a year, or depending on quantity take to Ferris College Optical Education building in Big Rapids. Call ahead first so they know when you are coming 231 591 3703 (Colleen Olson). They will arrange help if necessary.

### HEARING AIDS

If any are with glasses, collect and take them to the Carl Center at the CMU Medical building and give them at the reception desk. Only hearing aids less than 5 years old can be reused. It may be hard to determine age of hearing aids.
